



JOURNALISM AND MEDIA COMMUNICATION AT COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY JUNIOR COHORT GRADUATION RATES

Roughly 60% of JMC students join the program after entering at CSU with an undeclared status, after changing from another CSU major, or transferring from another school. The cohort of students enrolled at the start of the junior year provides the most accurate picture of graduation rates for students who are in the program and have at least two years to finish the degree.
